## **Talk With the Leadership**

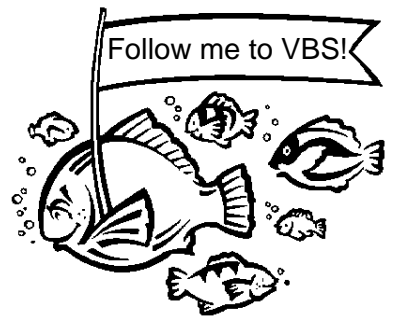

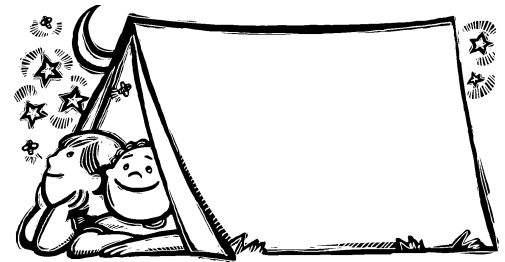
