The Quiet Room

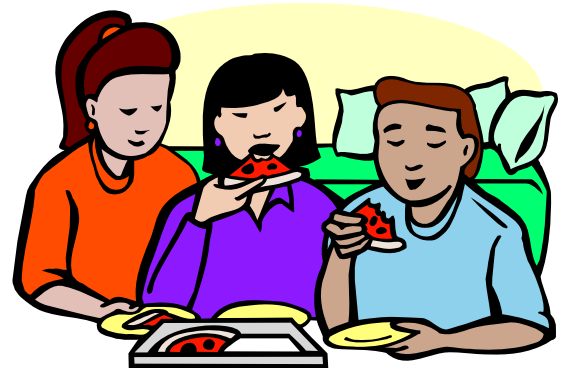
