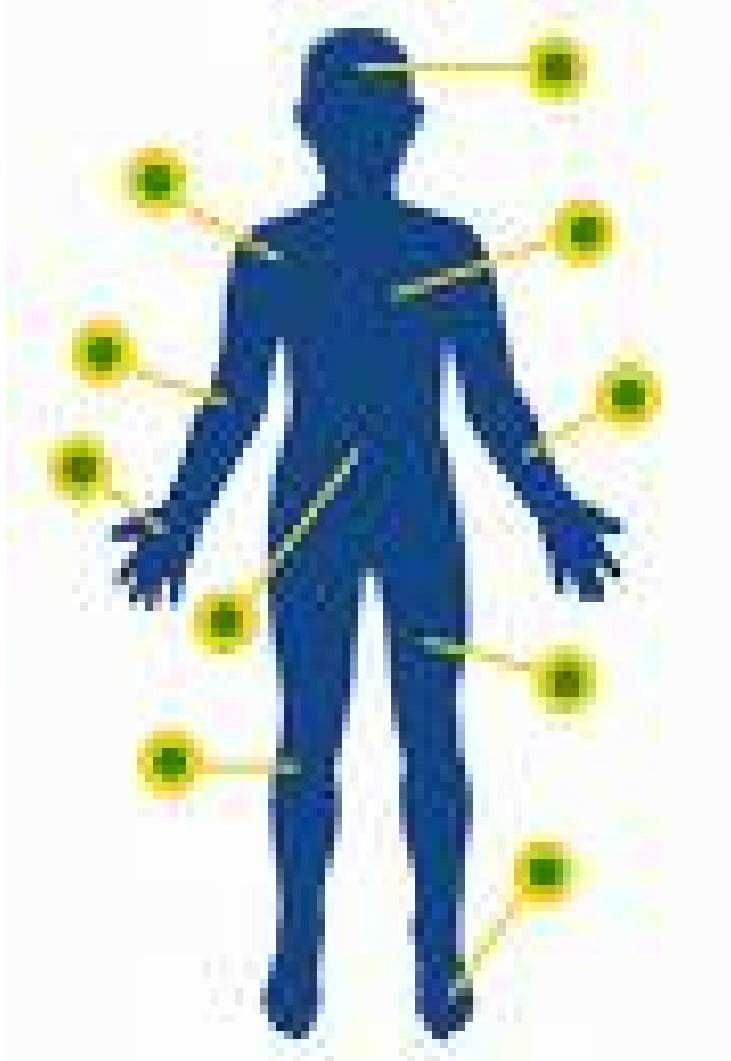

"Bringing people together and to God"

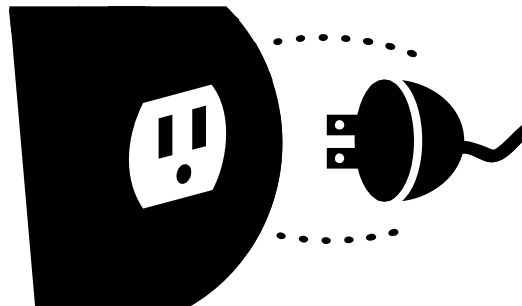
