

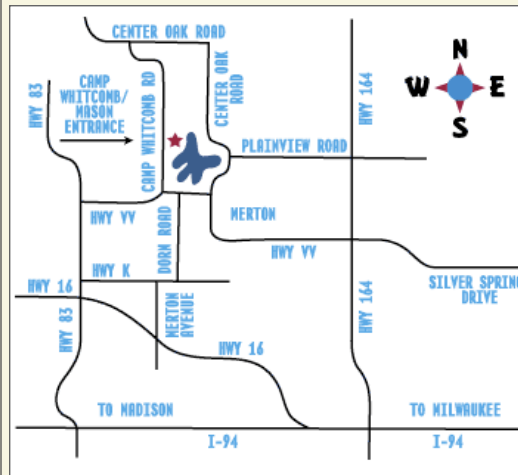


CAMP WHITCOMB-MASON

Camp Whitcomb/Mason is a year round facility located near Hartland, approximately 35 miles northwest of Milwaukee, on beautiful Lake Keesus.

Situated on 306 acres of hills, fields, wetlands, and forests, Whitcomb/Mason provides campers with a variety of natural experiences.

The mission of Camp Whitcomb/Mason is to provide an imaginative, outdoor educational/recreational experience where youth have the opportunity to develop a sense of competence, usefulness and belonging through their accomplishments, while developing skills, responsibility and respect for others in a safe and healthy non-urban environment.



DIRECTIONS

From Milwaukee

1. Take Hwy I-94 west towards Madison, exit at Hwy 16 west (Pewaukee exit) - Exit #293C
2. Continue on Hwy 16 and exit at North Avenue/Merton Avenue - Exit #183
3. At 4 way stop turn right onto Merton Avenue
4. When road ends (at 3 way stop) turn right onto Hwy K
5. Go one block and take first left which is Dorn Road Take Dorn Road until ends at Hwy V V (2.5 miles)
6. Turn left onto Hwy V V
7. Take first right, which is Camp Whitcomb Road
8. Drive 1.2 miles - camp entrance is on the right.

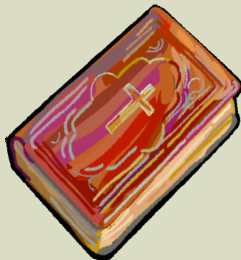
