CHRISTIAN RESPONSE TO DIVISIVE OPINIONS

Christians are missing the mark of relationships by getting caught up in divisive opinions. Some of those divisive opinions are politics, mask wearing, Covid-19, voting, policing policies, and social injustice protests. Paul makes it clear that the church is not to let any of these opinions to take precedent over loving one another.

For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit, because anyone who serves Christ in this way is pleasing to God and receives human approval. Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification. Do not destroy the work of God... or do anything else that will cause your brother or sister to fall. So, whatever you believe about these things, keep it between yourself and God. Blessed is the one who does not condemn himself by what he approves". Romans 14:17-22.



Four steps to making every effort to do what leads to peace:

1. Keep your opinions private
2. Focus on things that bring peace and mutual edification.
3. One's opinion can NEVER cause division in the church.
4. Make sure your opinion does not turn into the sin of divisiveness.
