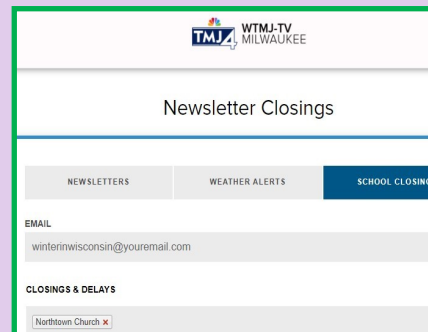

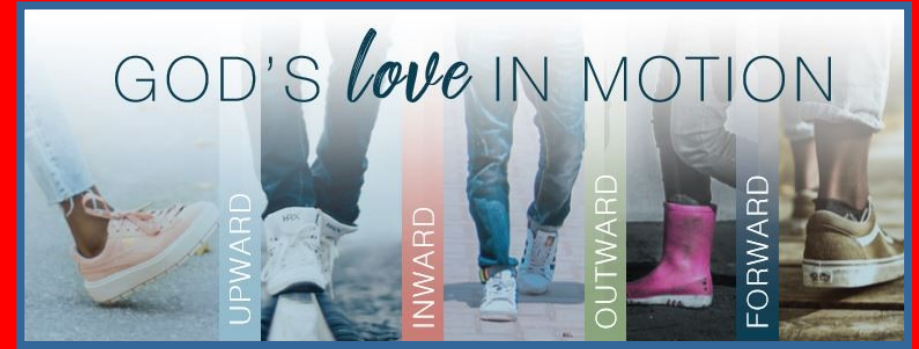

Scripture	2 Corinthians 1:2-4
Devotional	This week we will explore the power of Hope in providing comfort. Notice that the vertical relationship of comfort and compassion and the horizontal relationship. What does it mean as we are given comfort by God, that we can now comfort others?

Scripture	2 Corinthians 7:5-7
Devotional	The significant part of Paul's writing is his honesty about his situation. Paul questions whether the Corinthians are concerned about him. Titus brings news that the church is longing, in deep sorrow, and sincere concern for him. This news brings great joy to Paul. How can you be a Titus by letting them know you are thinking and praying for them?

Scripture	John 14:15-17
